Farmers and Communities Manage Deer is a successful program demonstrating that farmers, sportsmen, and community groups can work together to limit deer damage to crops, increase local farm and community revenue, and provide harvested venison to food pantries. The project engages local civic organizations, churches, hunt clubs, youth groups, and businesses as to support deer management programs in their community.

Project Goals:

- Increase annual crop income by reducing crop loss caused by deer
- Develop new annual farm revenues from short and long-term hunting leases
- Increase revenues for local gas stations, motels, and restaurants from influx of sportsmen
- Manage local deer herds for sustainable annual harvest and disease prevention
- Supply protein-rich venison to community food pantries and shelters, and
- Develop sustained community-wide participation in reaching deer harvest goals
